- Removal and re-installation of aircraft components (engine, flight control, equipment, etc.)

- Maintenance of AMO facilities and harbour bases

- Valid Transport Canada Aircraft Maintenance Engineer (M1) certification
- Previous aviation experience with fixed winged aircraft on wheels or floats

 - Flight control rigging
